

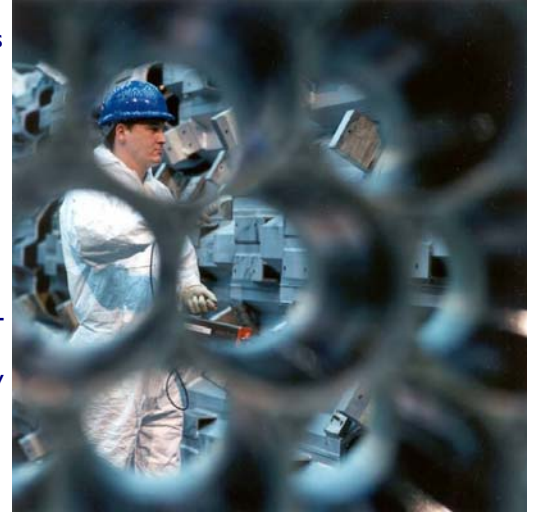
## 'Building Partnerships' in Decommissioning
